Autumn Term 2018

Dear Parent / Guardian,

We wish to welcome you back to the Autumn term. We hope that you and your family have had an enjoyable summer and we are looking forward to a successful first term.

This term our topic will be The Vikings. Within this topic we will incorporate geography, history, art and design technology.



During the Autumn Term, we will have daily lessons in English. We will be reading Beowulf and a selection of Viking based stories focusing on description and narrative writing. Hopefully the children will tell you more about this as they work through the stories. We will also be concentrating on our comprehension skills, continuing with our spelling scheme and working hard to improve our handwriting.



In Mathematics we will be Counting, looking at Place Value and Comparing with numbers to 10,000. We will also be working on Addition and subtraction within 10,000, multiplying by 3,4,6,7,8 & 9 and starting to look at written methods of Multiplication & Division. There will be a focus on solving word problems with the four operations too.

Science during the Autumn term will be Light and Shadows and Animals including humans.



In ICT, we will be using Coding to create simple animations and simulations. The children will access this using Espresso and Scratch software.

The children will begin to learn French, beginning with basic conversational French.



In RE, we will focus on worship and festivities—How and why do Hindus celebrate Diwali.
