#### **Girls:**

Grey or navy blue skirt, trousers or pinafore dress  
White blouse or polo shirt  
Navy blue cardigan or sweatshirt with school logo (Nursery to Year 5)  
Royal blue cardigan or sweatshirt with school logo (Year 6)

#### **Boys:**

Grey trousers  
White shirt or polo shirt  
Navy blue sweatshirt with school logo (Nursery to Year 5)  
Royal blue sweatshirt with school logo (Year 6)

#### **P.E. Kit**

Royal blue P.E. t-shirt with school logo and navy shorts and trainers.

**It is essential** that all uniform is clearly labelled with your child's name and class.

#### **Footwear/socks**

All children should have black school shoes. Children should wear dark socks (boys) or plain white socks (girls). Multi coloured socks must not be worn.

#### **Jewellery/Nail Polish**

With the exception of watches, earring studs, jewellery should not be worn in school. Nail polish should not be worn in school.
