

Science We will be studying Electricity and Sound this term. We will learn how electricity is made, looking at renewable sources of energy, learning how to make a complete circuit and incorporating switches into circuits. We will learn how sound is produced and how it travels.

Geography This term we will be learning about the Earth and its Extreme Weather; we will be learning how hurricanes, tornadoes and tsunamis form, the effects of each of these extreme weathers.

Art and D&T We will learn how to make a collage using a variety of methods, such as ripping paper to create texture; we will use charcoal to produce a picture of a tornado; we will make a lighthouse and incorporate a circuit.

Literacy Our class books this term will be 'James and the Giant Peach' and 'Flat Stanley'. We will be learning how to use punctuation, including speech marks, correctly. We will be learning to write exciting sentences using appropriate adjectives, verbs and adverbs in our writing. We will learn how to use nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs correctly. In Year 4, we learn how to use fronted adverbials.



French This term we will learn how to talk about the weather in French; how to ask questions about the weather and how to answer questions about the weather.

RE We are learning about the pilgrimages, the special journeys, that people of faith go on. We will be learning about major world religions, as well as Christianity.

Maths This term we will be learning how to add and subtract amounts of money, using £.p notation, and how to solve problems involving money. We will be learning how to convert lengths using mm, cm, m and km; how to convert mass using g and kg; how to convert capacity using ml, cl and litres. We will be learning how to represent tenths and hundredths on a place value chart and how to multiply and divide by 10 and 100;

PE Children should bring their PE kit into school and leave it in school until the half-term. PE kit is needed each Tuesday and Thursday.

Music We will be using the Charanga music scheme to ensure full coverage of the music curriculum in Y4. We will be learning to appreciate a range of music.

Computing We will begin to learn how to stay safe on the internet. We will look at ways of being a responsible digital citizen and what we can do to keep ourselves safe online. We will be learning to create Photo stories, using software to add photos and text to create comic strips, adding soundtracks and captions.
